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








Vehicle identification



Prevent the vehicle from rolling

- 1. Put the selector lever in the Park (P) position.
- 2. Apply the parking brake.

Deactivate the drive and the high-voltage system

Deactivating the drive and the high-voltage system (when the ignition and fuse panel can be accessed from the interior)





1. Turn the ignition key to the "OFF" position and remove it, or press the "Start Engine Stop" button.




Once the airbag control module has discharged (approximately 4 seconds), passive safety systems such as the airbags and belt tensioners are deactivated by turning the key to the "OFF" position.

The airbags could deploy before the airbag control

module discharges if the airbag system is damaged.







Remove the storage compartment above the fuse panel on the left.
 Pull out the marked fuse.
 (yellow flag)



The high-voltage system will be de-energized about 20 seconds after deactivation.

The passive safety systems such as airbags and belt tensioners are then deactivated.









Deactivate the drive and the high-voltage system


Deactivating the drive and the high-voltage system (when the engine compartment is accessible).



1. Disconnect the 12 V battery



2. Locate the First Responders disconnecting point



3. Open the First Responders disconnecting point The procedure is described on the tag.



The high-voltage system will be de-energized about 20 seconds after deactivation. The passive safety systems such as airbags and belt tensioners are then deactivated.

Vehicles connected to charging pillars

Unlock the vehicle. Disconnect the charging cable from the vehicle and, in the event of a severe accident, deactivate the vehicle's high-voltage system (see "Deactivating the vehicle").

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
